

Guests were welcomed with bouquets by the students. Principal of the college deliver the welcome speech and highlighted the significance of organizing Indian Philosophers' Day. Dr. Manisha Tripathy, HOD, Department of Philosophy gave the key note address and in her welcome address and introductory remarks, she highlighted the significance of celebrating Indian Philosophers' Day. The 2nd session held at 2 PM at the Madhusudan Auditorium of the college with another two Lecture Programmes. Dr. Sangita Misra, Principal of the College presided over this session. Dr. Manisha Tripathy, HOD of the department pointing to the major philosophical branches, i.e., Epistemology, Aesthetics and Ethics.
