The statue cleaning drive is a significant part of the Social Service and Community Development (SSCD) activities undertaken by the National Cadet Corps (NCC) Cadets. It is a practical exercise that instills a sense of civic responsibility, respect for national heritage, and the value of dignity of labor.

Purpose of Statue Cleaning by NCC Cadets:

NCC cadets view the cleaning and maintenance of statues of national leaders and prominent personalities as an act of tribute and respect. The activity serves multiple purposes:

- **Honoring National Icons:** It is a direct way for the youth to acknowledge and pay homage to the historical figures who have contributed to the nation's progress and culture.
- **Civic Responsibility:** The drive promotes the value of maintaining public monuments and monuments, encouraging cadets to become proactive and disciplined citizens.

Execution of the Cleaning Activity:

The statue cleaning drive is typically organized at the Unit or Battalion level and often includes the following steps:

- **Preparation:** Cadets, under the supervision of their Associate NCC Officers (ANOs) and Permanent Instructor (PI) staff, identify the statues or monuments in the college campus or nearby public areas.
- **Cleaning:** The cadets thoroughly clean the statues and their surrounding areas, which often involves:
 - Washing and scrubbing the statue to remove dust, dirt, and pollutants.
 - Clearing litter and debris from the base and surrounding park/area.
 - Cleaning and sometimes repainting nameplates or plaques.
 - Using appropriate, often eco-friendly, cleaning materials to avoid damaging the historical structure.
- **Public Awareness:** Alongside the physical cleaning, cadets frequently organize short events like **street plays (Nukkad Nataks)** or awareness rallies to engage the public and deliver messages on cleanliness, anti-vandalism, and preserving national heritage.

This activity is a recurring feature in the NCC's calendar, showcasing the commitment of the cadets to selfless service and nation-building beyond traditional military training.
